

The Swang, Bhagat and Nautanki forms of traditional Indian theatre

Dr. Devendra Sharma is a performer, writer, and director of Svāṅg-Nauṭaṅkī, Rāslīlā Bhagat, and Rasiyā, the traditional musical theatre genres of northern India. He belongs to a long lineage of Swang-Nautanki expeonents going back at least four generations. Dr Sharma was trained in the Swami-Khera Akhara (school) by the traditional guru, Pandit Ram Dayal Sharma. He has given more than 500 performances to date worldwide, and directed many films illustrating Indian folk traditions and culture.
